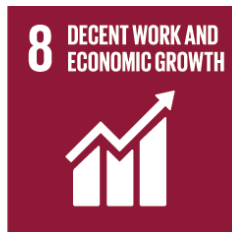

The overall approach

- Sustainable development
= economic, ecological and social development

- A matter of knowledge:

Knowledge – Awareness – Willingness - Action

- An integrated part of the project
- See the bigger picture (look at things from a wider perspective)
- Communication
- Cross-border perspective



Ecological sustainability

- How does the project relate to fossil fuels and the use of chemicals? (eg. selection in procurement, travel arrangements, products at conferences and seminars etc.)
- The project should be a role model based on resource efficiency and recycling – circular economy

Gender equality



- Interventions target both women and men?
- Enhance stereotypes or break patterns?
- Current statistics?
- Gender distribution in the project organization?
- Communication? Keep symbolism in mind!

Equal opportunities and non-discrimination

- Diversity is an asset and provides increased attractiveness
- Knowledge within the project organization
- Can everyone participate? (disability, ethnicity, language, etc)
- Communication? Keep symbolism in mind
